



Criteria for participation

Objectives of the conference:

- Launch of the EPF Campaign on Patient Empowerment;
- Explore the concept of empowerment, including key aspects identified in the EMPATHIE study:
 - o Information to patients and health literacy
 - o The new patient-health professional relationship and shared decision-making
 - self-management, including the potential of technology
- Explore existing good practices, challenges and pitfalls related to empowerment from the perspectives of different stakeholders;
- Reflect on approaches to operationalising and measuring patient empowerment;
- Show the current evidence-base and identify gaps and opportunities in relation to further research.
