Some realisations

- We are in a different environment than 5 years ago;
- Health is at risk: it is not about raising the voice of patients but about raising the "voice of health";
- There are lots of uncertainties: total amount of budget, Brexit, rise of Euroscepticism
- Status quo is an unlikely scenario

- Fall 2017 Work with MEPS on the Parliament's report on the future EU budget

- March 2018 Breakfast Briefing with Health Attachés
- April 2018 Joint statement with EPHA: "To protect and advance what matters most to everyone in Europe: A Commission Vice-President for Health"
