EPF Youth Strategy

Why a Youth Strategy?

 Adopted by the EPF 2011 AGM to enable EPF to recognise, understand and effectively represent the needs and expectations of young patients through their meaningful involvement and empowerment

Rationale behind the Youth Strategy:

- Needs and expectations of young patients do not necessarily match those of adult patients
- Chronic conditions have important repercussions on young people's growth and the way they go through education, finding jobs, etc.
- Patient organisations need to listen to young patients and provide them with appropriate tools and avenues through which their needs and expectations can be put forward



EPF Youth Strategy

What are the Goals?

GOAL 1: Strengthening the involvement and representation of young patients in patient organisations

GOAL 2: Promoting young patients' rights and recognition of their needs and expectations within and beyond health policy area

GOAL 3: Promoting a better cooperation between young patient and adult patient advocates

GOAL 4: Strengthening young patient representatives' skills and self-confidence



EPF Youth Group

- Set up in April 2011 as the **backbone** of the EPF Youth Strategy
- The Youth Group is the reference group though which needs and expectations of the young patient community are formulated and communicated to EPF
- Currently made up of **11 young patient representatives** between 15 and 25 years of age nominated by EPF members

- Policy discussions on selected topics
- Simulations of press conference
- Workshops on opportunities for patients involvements
- Trainings (EU institutions and advocacy)
