NCP provides information to:

- Belgian patients and health professionals on the rights and entitlements to CBH care
- foreign insured patients (who are considering medical treatment in Belgium) on the Belgian health care system





Information to Belgian patients/health professionals:

- rights to and reimbursement of CHB-care
- list of health care subject to prior authorisation + how to apply for a prior authorisation
- procedures for appeal
- situations:
 - temporary stay & planned health care
 - NOT: health care entitlements when moving abroad





Information to foreign insured patients: e.g.

- right of health care provider to provide services (and possible restrictions)
- accessibility of hospitals for persons with disabilities
- patient rights
- complaints procedures & procedures to seek redress
- possibilities to seek remedies in case of harm
- quality and safety standards
- Belgian invoices





NCP does not provide information on:

- rights and entitlements of other MS
- health care systems in other MS
 - referral to NCP of MS concerned
- LTC-care (home care services, nursing homes, ...)
- complementary health care insurances
- organ donation
- nursing facilities for persons with disabilities, child care, ...




Protocol Agreement of 24 June 2013 between federal government and federated entities concerning the organisation and financing of the NCP
