Why EU eHealth policies?



- Member States are responsible for providing safe, high quality, efficient and quantitatively adequate healthcare to citizens on their territory BUT
 - It is possible for patients to receive cross-border healthcare
 - Directive 2011/24 once transposed will provide legal certainty for cross border care
- MS are facing common challenges to make eHealth a tool for providing sustainable, high quality, safe and accessible health care

Patient centered EU eHealth priorities




- Digital Agenda E2020
 - Key Action 13 : Undertake pilot actions to equip Europeans with secure **online access** to their medical health data by 2015 and to achieve by 2020 widespread **deployment of telemedicine services**.
 - Key Action 14: Propose a recommendation defining a minimum common set of patient data for interoperability of patient records to be accessed or exchanged electronically across Member States by 2012.




Continuity of care and safety for citizens travelling in the EU: Directive 2011/24EU

CALLIOPE- personal Statements...



As a patient, I expect to get high quality personalized healthcare on an equal access basis, regardless of my social status and where I am located, with full respect of my privacy. I want to be in the centre of the care process and benefit from personalised care. I wish to be empowered and coached to choose where I need to go to be cared; when ill, to stay at home as much as possible and spend as little time as possible in hospitals. I want to be mobile and to be guaranteed **Safe care anytime and anywhere** with the doctor, the nurse or the pharmacist treating me having access to my health data medication that I take, allergies and chronic conditions - just like at home. To be able to trust the healthcare system,

I need guarantees that my privacy is protected, my personal preferences are observed, the information needed to care for me safely is available as appropriate and I am part of any decisions regarding my condition.








IOp Model, i2010 subgroup of eHealth; I2Health




