- 1. Implement and further develop MHE's Fundraising strategy 2013-2018
- 2. Support Director in writing project applications and report about ongoing projects
- 3. Increase the contributions of individuals and groups to MHE by building relationships and exploring new fundraising opportunities from various sources (community, corporate, foundations, individual donations, events...).

Requirements for the position

Essential:

- Good knowledge of the mental health field or proven interest or experience in the sector
- Understanding of and commitment to the social model of disability
- Fluency in English (written, spoken)
- Excellent communication skills and good analytical skills
- High sense of priority setting and ability to react quickly
- Excellent networking skills
- Ability to work autonomously and to take initiatives
- Good social skills and ability to work in a small, busy, international team
- Willingness to travel and to work in weekends when necessary
- Computer literacy
- Good knowledge of European Media as well as of EU policies and institutions;
- Knowledge of and experience in modern communications including social media
- Web content management skills
- Ability to synthesize and communicate complex information in a way that is adapted to a specific audience
