Project design to request funding:

#### **Positive**

- Helps to adapt to key health priorities in your country
- Strategy of the organization with this focus to achieve funding

#### **Negative**

- Complex proceses, costly and timeconsuming in incubation stage
- Often reverses real patient unmet needs and forces adapting to government policy

#### **Patient Organizations structures:**

- Too many, and don't professionalise their services. Need better coordination
- Compete for funding and recognition, sometimes unfairly
- Not a level-playing field
- Needs accreditation process to ensure quality in organization management for better project and implementation and support better resource capture

- •Small organizations should also have access to funding especially core funding (not recognised) to support fixed costs and infrastructure
- •Vulnerable to survival in current situation
- Patient organizations should be results-driven to demonstrate capabilities and compete better
- Umbrella organizations can be an obstacle to access and achieve funding
