It is our great pleasure to invite you to a Patient Evidence Workshop focusing on Patient Safety that will take place in Brussels at EPF premises, **on Thursday 21 November 2013, from 9.30 to 16.00.**

The event will focus on shaping EPF contributions to EU-level actions in the patient safety area, focusing on patient involvement in patient safety.

This workshop will be an opportunity to discuss achievements and future EPF objectives concerning patient safety and share experiences on patient involvement in patient safety. It will also help building the EPF “patients’ evidence-base” for future work. You can find the draft agenda [here](#).

The expected outcomes of the workshop are related to the development of recommendations and new ideas on future actions in relation to the EU recommendations on patient safety and how patients and families can contribute to reporting and learning systems and the education and training of professionals – topics to feed into the EC Patient Safety and Quality Working Group.
