The session challenged traditional perceptions of leadership, focusing on the future, concrete actions, and inclusive engagement.

During the session, Konstantina delivered a powerful intervention emphasizing the need to create meaningful space for young patients to lead. "Experience isn't just measured in years; it's about daily realities and deep personal insight," she reflected. Her compelling call to "shift the system" captured the essence of a more inclusive, forward-thinking patient movement.

At PEOF, Marleen Sorensen also contributed meaningfully to the broader discussions, drawing attention to the importance of amplifying underrepresented voices in healthcare, including women's health, marginalized communities, and the essential contributions of youth in co-creating equitable policies.
