#### EPF PUBLISHES POSITION PAPER ON "ADHERENCE AND CONCORDANCE"



EPF released in March 2015 a position paper on adherence and concordance. With this document, we aim to clarify the terminology of adherence from the patients' perspective. We also position this topic firmly in the context of patient-centred healthcare, patient empowerment, shared decision-making, information and health literacy.

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EPF PUBLISHES STATEMENT ON THE COMMUNICATION OF CLINICAL TRIAL RESULTS



Transparency about the results of clinical trials is one of the key achievements of the new EU clinical trials regulation that entered into force in June 2014. EPF just released a position statement on the standards for communication on the lay summary to complement our previous paper on the publication of the trial results and the EU database.

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#### CROSSING BORDERS FOR HEALTHCARE IN SPAIN, POLAND AND BULGARIA



EPF continues to raise awareness on the Cross-Border Healthcare Directive and to monitor its implementation across Europe.
