It is our pleasure to share with you the report of the successful kick-off meeting of our campaign on Access to Healthcare, which took place in the European Parliament on the 27th of February. The meeting offered the opportunity to explore and discuss the campaign's objectives and focal points. MEPs, stakeholders, and patients' representatives all shared ideas for avenues to achieve Universal Health Coverage by 2030. #Access2030

In the course of 2016, EPF ran a **survey** among patients' representatives to understand their perception of **quality of care**. The report, featured in this issue of our newsletter shows how the image of quality very much depends on the context where healthcare is provided and that it encompasses many dimensions of health and social care. The survey's results are telling and should encourage policy-makers to invest in more qualitative methods to capture patients' feedback.

As you may remember from previous Newsletters, a "new" **EUPATI** programme is moving forward under the direction of EPF maintaining the spirit of a Public Private Partnership, and with a newly-formed EUPATI Management Team. Now is the time for an official introduction! You may recognise familiar faces from the EUPATI network but there are a few big changes too.
