  - EMA: continuing engagement in PCWP + representation on MB
  - OECD: standing invitation to HCQO WG + PaRIS advisory council, new PRIMs survey
  - WHO European regional office health systems strengthening & people-centredness...
- EPF Congress patient involvement ensuring strong links and "actionability" of outcomes in future policy & advocacy work at different levels
  - E.g. Patient involvement in HTA regardless of the "fate" of the policy file
