EPF Five Legitimacy Criteria





Legitimacy

EPF member organisations should be registered in one of the EU member states.



Democracy

EPF members should have governing bodies, which are elected by their members, who shall be patients, theirs carers, or their elected representatives.



Representation

EPF pan-European diseasespecific organisations should have members of their own in more than half of the EU member states.

National platforms should represent at least 10 different diseases groups to be accepted as Full Members.



Accountability & Consultation

Statements and opinions should reflect the views and opinions of their memberships, and consultation procedures with those memberships should be put in place.

Transparency

EPF member should generally disclose their sources of funding and generally make available their audited financial accounts.
