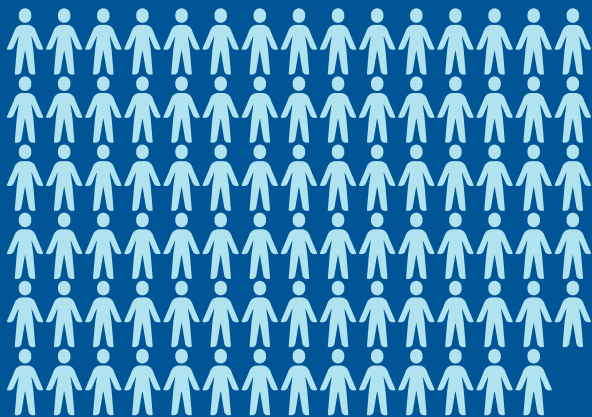


SURVEY REPORT ON CONTINUING PROFESSIONAL EDUCATION (CPE)



CPE is a form of continuing education for healthcare professionals (HCPs) that aim to maintain, develop, and increase their knowledge and skills.

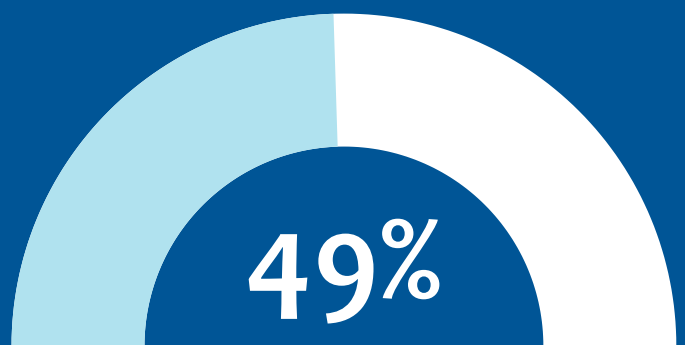
EPF surveyed its Membership on this topic to gain insights into their experiences of involvement in CPE activities.



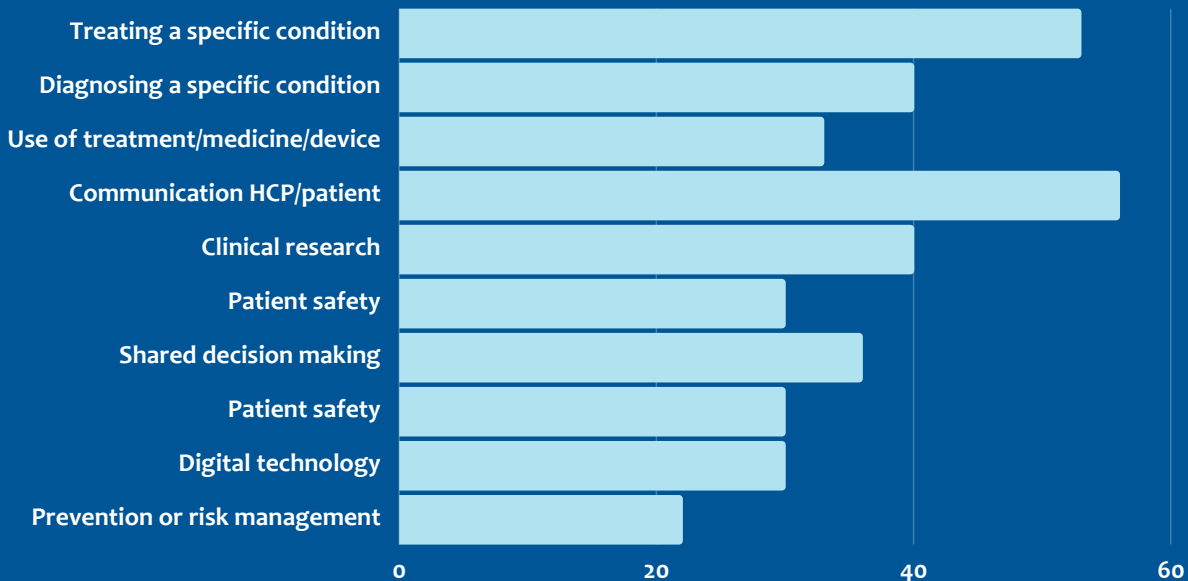

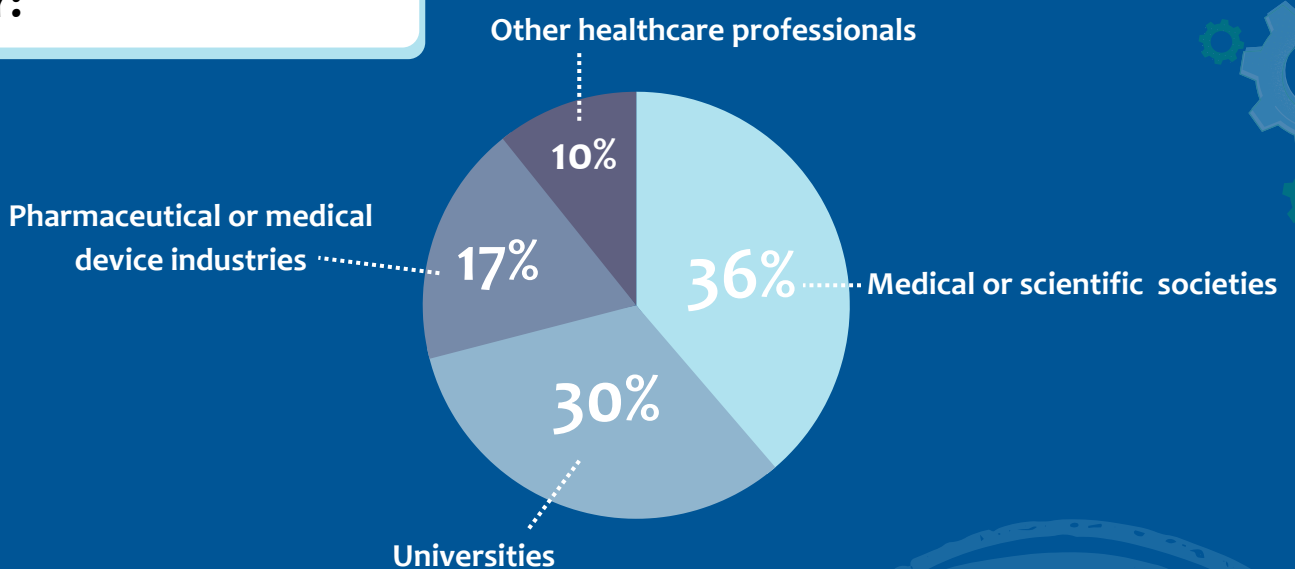
HAVE YOU EVER BEEN INVOLVED IN CPE ACTIVITIES?
